<Types of Plagiarism>

The following types of plagiarism are considered by the journal:

- Full/complete Plagiarism:

Previously published content with absolutely no modification to the text, idea and grammar. It involves presenting exact text from a source as one's own work.

- Partial Plagiarism:

Content is a mixture from multiple different sources, where the author has rephrased text without doing the actual research.

- Self-Plagiarism:

Act of reusing their pre-published research. If you wish to include any text, ideas, or data that already appeared in your past work, inform of this by citing your own work.
