and Senior Advisor of the United Nations University**Talk on..****Evolution** of the *United Nations' role in maintenance of international peace and security* ensuring respect and promotion of human rights during 70 years of the UN existence.**Synergy** of the peace roles developed mostly because of the need to ensure *protection of civilians* and respect for *human rights* in fragile post-conflict environments.**Peacekeeping** & peacebuilding remain important roles, and there is need for a clarity between the engaging actors how they will ensure coordination and respect for human rights.**Evolution** of peacekeeping: With *lessons from Bosnia, Somalia, Rwanda, Sierra Leone, DR Congo*, examines how the protection of civilians has been gradually given more attention and added into the mandates of peace operations.**Peacebuilding** is an effort to sustain the peace long-term and avoid re-occurrence of conflicts, and this is primarily possible through a vigorous system of protecting human rights.**June 8 MON, 2015 12:20 ~ 13:50**Karasuma Campus, **Shikokan SK118**
