Evolution of the United Nations' role in maintenance of international peace and security ensuring respect and promotion of human rights during 70 years of the UN existence.

Synergy of the peace roles developed mostly because of the need to ensure protection of civilians and respect for human rights in fragile post-conflict environments.

Peacekeeping & peacebuilding remain important roles, and there is need for a clarity between the engaging actors how they will ensure coordination and respect for human rights.

Eevolution of peacekeeping: With lessons from Bosnia, Somalia, Rwanda, Sierra Leone, DR Congo, examines how the protection of civilians has been gradually given more attention and added into the mandates of peace operations.

Peacebuilding is an effort to sustain the peace long-term and avoid re-occurrence of conflicts, and this is primarily possible through a vigorous system of protecting human rights.
