Eligibility for application has changed.

- For the 3rd semester student (M2), the requirement to aim to go to the doctoral course and complete the program **is not imposed** at the time of application.
- Students who pass the Examination are **eligible to receive Activity Financial Support** (mainly domestic/overseas travel expenses) for the GRM courses.
