

This documentary film illustrates the interconnectedness of the human cycle, showing scenes of destruction and resurgence. The film's visual work of art explores the ties between mankind and nature; how our lifecycle is with the rhythm of the earth. The word "Samsara" is from Sanskrit, meaning 'the ever-turning wheel of life.'

The Storyline of the Film (Content)

SAMSARA is a non-verbal documentary, filmed over nearly 5 years in 25 countries. It is one of only a handful of films shot on 70mm in the last forty years. The film explores the marvels of the world and the richness of the human experience. It transports us to the diverse world of sacred grounds, disasters zones, industrial complexes, natural wonders. With its acclaimed mesmerizing visuals and music, Samsara leaves out dialogue and descriptive texts. It goes beyond expectation of traditional documentary. The film encourages the viewer to capture the miraculous and the greatest depths of human spirituality, yet challenging us to appreciate the beauty of the world despite the occurring pain and tragedies.
