After Brexit: The Battle for Europe

This documentary tackles the rise of Eurosceptic populist movements across the continent. The film shows leading political figures admit the EU is in crisis and on the brink of collapse.

The Storyline of the Film (Content)

Many of us still don't really know what Brexit means? On a bold mission, this documentary film explores the implications and ramification of the seismic political decision of Brexit of 2016 (and Trumpism for that matter) on the European continent. The film's investigation focuses on the rise of populist Eurosceptic movement across Europe. The reporter goes to France, Italy, Hungary and Brussels, speaking to players including Front National Head Marine Le Pen; Beppe Grillo, the leader of Italy's antiestablishment Five Star Movement. The new political pressure such movements put on the EU itself is evident. Martin Schulz, the former president of the European Parliament, admitted there was a "real risk" the EU will fall apart as populism rises. The documentary asks if the union can survive this rightwing onslaught?
