A Silent revolution is moving across the world. Renewable energy is becoming cheaper than from fossil fuels. What main factor will ultimately determine the widespread acceptance and use of solar and wind energy? In a word: cost.

The Storyline of the Film (Content)

This documentary film travels the globe to discover where these seismic advancements in renewable energy are taking place. The filmmakers provide an example of a recent solar project in the United Arab Emirates which confirms that the cost of unsubsidized renewable energy is now cheaper than that of fossil fuels. In countries like Brazil, Australia, Chile and parts of the United States people consider renewable energy because of financial reasons. The price of solar and wind energy will continue to drop and in more countries renewable energy will occur. A surprising newcomer on the market is Morocco, where the government expects that in 2020 more than 40 percent of the energy could come from solar energy. This film takes us inside the corporate offices and production lines where this groundbreaking work is being done, and examines what it could mean for the future of energy consumption on Earth.
